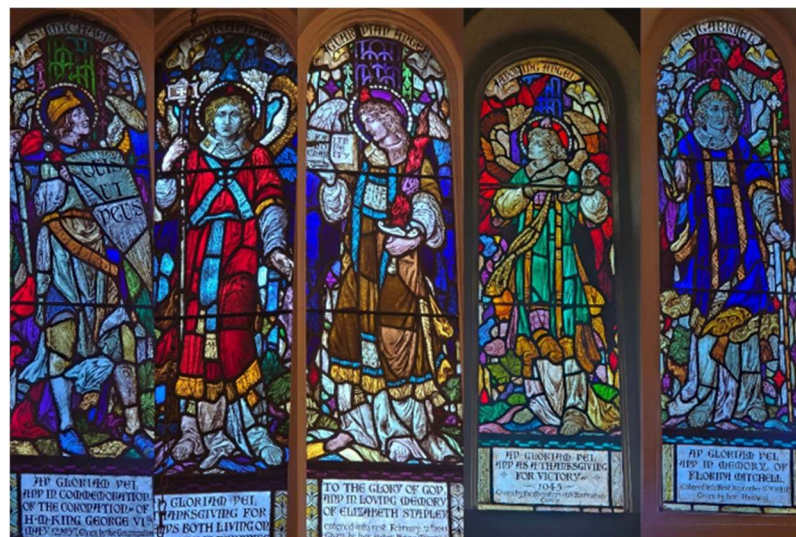

## THE LITURGY OF THE WORD
